GUEST SERVICES

Located in the Museum's main lobby, Guest Services is your resource for Museum amenities and services, including tickets to temporary exhibitions, maps, brochures, audio tours, and information about programs.

WHEELCHAIRS

A limited number of wheelchairs are available from Guest Services on a first-come, first-served basis, at no cost. ADA-approved canes are also available.

CHECKING LARGE BAGS

Large items, including large purses, backpack-style child carriers, tripods, umbrellas, or any item larger than 11" x 15" are not allowed in the galleries and should be left in your vehicle or in the checkroom. Checkrooms are located in the lower lobby (below the main lobby), and adjacent to the south lobby. Self-service lockers are available at no cost.

EXPERIENCE ART STUDIO

Experience Art Studio is a fun discovery space for both children and adults to explore various ways of looking at and thinking about works of art. There is also a creative play space and art-making space. Accessible from the lower North Exhibition gallery or from Walker Landing.

WIFI

Complimentary wireless Internet access is available in all the indoor public spaces.

PICNICKING ON THE GROUNDS

Picnicking is encouraged on Museum trails and grounds. We ask that guests not bring coolers, chairs, or other gear onto Walker Landing.

Dinner: Wed and Fri | 5 to 9 pm



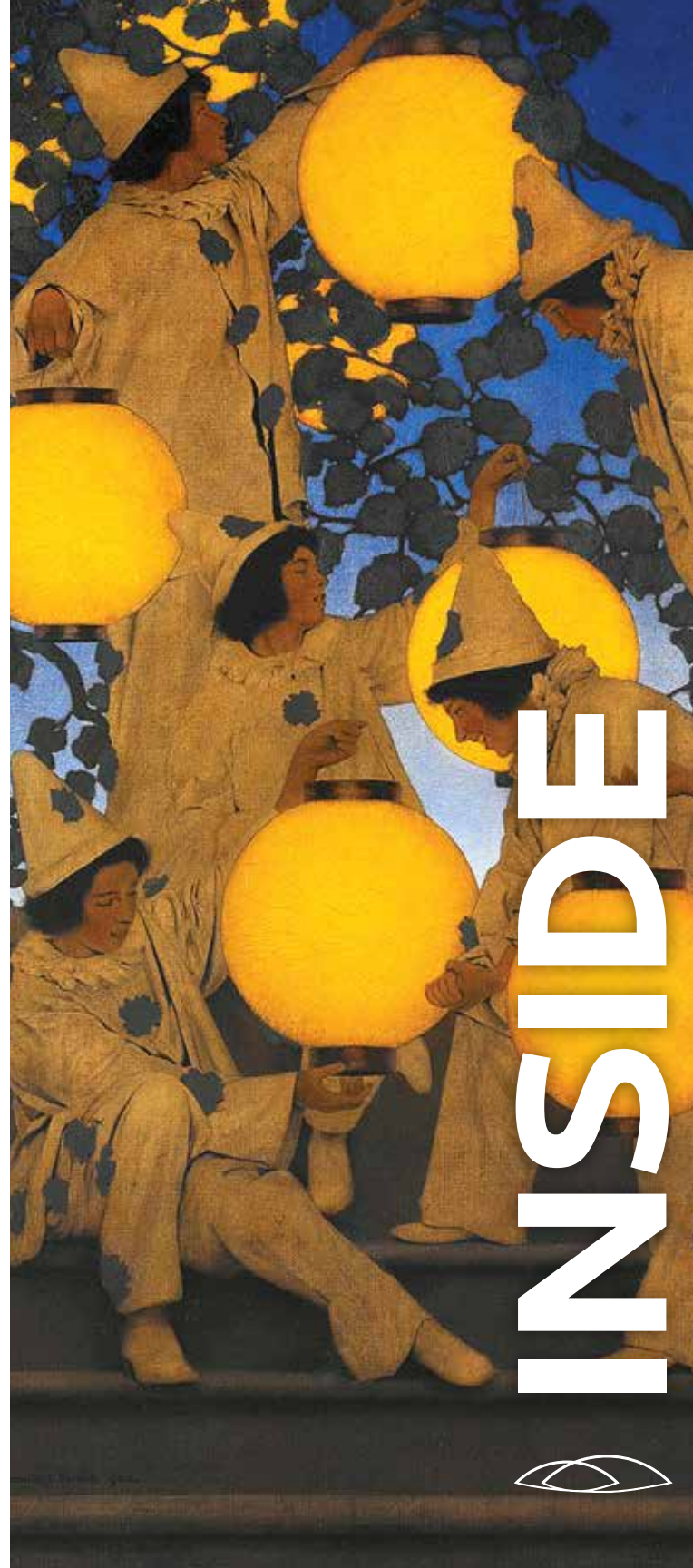
LIBRARY

The Library offers a large collection of art reference materials and is open during all Museum public hours. There is also a changing display of materials from the Library's collection of rare books. Computers are available for guests.



MUSEUM STORE

Designed by architect Marlon Blackwell, the Museum Store offers a wide selection of books, gifts, jewelry, prints of works from the Crystal Bridges collection, and works by regional artists.



Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art features more than 400 works by American masters that highlight the full scope of American art and history. The collection has been arranged chronologically to tell the story of America's history as seen by its artists.

MUSEUM GUIDELINES

Please do not touch works of art, as any contact can damage the surface of a painting or sculpture. Please do not lean on walls or cases.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Photography of works in the permanent collection is allowed (for personal use), provided that no tripod, monopod, or flash is used. Temporary exhibitions may not allow photography. Please check for signage about restrictions as you enter a temporary exhibition, or ask an attendant.

FOOD AND DRINK

No outside food or drinks may be brought into the Museum. Chewing gum and beverages (including water bottles) are not allowed in Museum galleries or the Museum Store.

SKETCHING

Sketching with pencils or colored pencils is permitted. Easels and other materials are not permitted. Sketch pads should be no larger than 11" x 14".

SMOKING

The Crystal Bridges campus is tobacco-free except for a designated smoking area. Consult Guest Services for location.

PUBLIC TOURS

The Museum offers regularly scheduled free drop-in tours. Each tour will take 45 minutes to one hour. Inquire at Guest Services for a listing of current tour offerings and times.

SELF-GUIDED TOURS

Self-guided tours highlight many of the Museum's most important works and are organized around certain themes. You may pick up printed tour information in the main lobby.

GROUP TOURS
